ISAM announces change of seat and opens professional office at Activaero GmbH

Gemünden, Germany. (Jan 5, 2006) – The International Society for Aerosols in Medicine (ISAM) today announced that, as of November 2005, it is registered in Germany as a scientific non-profit organization. The change of seat was decided by the general assembly during the ISAM Congress in Perth, Australia in June, 2005. As a result of this change, ISAM's organization in Austria will be closed in 2006 and its administrative operations will be transferred to Activaero GmbH in Gemünden, Germany. The new ISAM office will be responsible for membership support and finance administration services.
